Minutes of the May 14, 2014 Meeting of the Jamestown Harbor Commission Approved: 6/11/2014

A meeting of the Jamestown Harbor Commission (JHC) was held Wednesday, May 14, 2014 at the Jamestown Town Hall, 93 Narragansett Avenue, Jamestown, Rhode Island.
