(34±) feet southeasterly from Sta. 68+23± of said traverse line; thence northerly \$long said property division line to a point, said point being opposite and twentyfive (25) feet southeasterly from Sta. 68+44± of said traverse line; thence northeasterly in a line parallel to and twenty-five (25) feet southeasterly from said traverse line to a point opposite Sta. 73+32± of said traverse line and also said point being in the range of the southerly boundary line of Brook St., so-called; thence easterly along said range line, to its intersection with the edge of Marragan sett Bay, said point of intersection being opposite and one hundred twentyfour more or less (124 \pm) feet southeasterly from the tangent line of a curve, having its point of curvature at Sta, 73+62.04, at a point four more or less (4±) feet northeasterly from said point of curvature; thence northwesterly along the edge of Narragansett Bay to its intersection with the division line between the property now or formerly owned by Mary H.
