The Town began the process of Hazard Mitigation Planning several years ago and has a draft Hazard Mitigation Plan that was prepared by the Planning Department and has been through several review cycles with FEMA which generated comments for revision. The State of Rhode Island, in an effort to standardize the process including the plans has become much more involved from a guidance and review standpoint. For this reason, we need some professional assistance to assist the Town in amending the plan and taking it through the proper public process. We received a \$9,750 RIEMA grant last year for this purpose. I have been working with Chief Mello who has assisted in developing a Request for Proposals for the Hazard Mitigation Plan Update. The RFP was advertised on October 3, 2013 in the Jamestown Press Legal Ads asking for qualified consultants with experience in Hazard Mitigation Planning. In addition, we solicited bids from all consultants on the State of Rhode Island Master Price Agreement list for Emergency Management Services. The proposals were reviewed for responsiveness to the bid. We developed a range of criteria for consultant selection including Firm profile and experience, similar projects, schedule, budget, current workload, sub-contractors, location and project approach.

We were very fortunate to receive 3 responsive proposals from extremely qualified Rhode Island firms to our Request for Proposal. They are as follows:

The firms had varying capabilities and project experience. Both Maguire and VHB were listed on the RI Master Price Agreement list of qualified consultants. Based on the qualifications and price, we are recommending that the Town Council award the

contractfor the Hazard Mitigation Update to VanasseHangenBrustlin, Inc.at a cost not to exceed \$9,500 which is within the grant amount.
