V. Old Business

1. Jamestown Zoning Ordinance Amendment – Findings of Fact and Consistency Statement

Town Planner Lisa Bryer went over the Findings of Fact and Consistency statement with Peter Ruggeiro's comments included.

Commissioner Bennett commented that she thinks that number 12 should be moved up and emphasized regarding the Comprehensive Plan.
