### REPORT OF TOWN OFFICIALS

1) Pumping Report:

The Public Works Director reported the following:

- o Pumping was average for the month of January.
- o Rainfall was below average for the month of January.
- Color level at north reservoir increased marginally for the month of January. This is a common occurrence this time of the year, when a layer of ice and snow cover the reservoir and prevent sunlight from penetrating the water.
- o North Reservoir was @ capacity, usable storage-60MG
- o South Pond is @ capacity, usable storage-7MG.

- 2) Town project reports: (See Project Update Report dated January 2009)
  The Public Works Director stated that he had enclosed of copy of the Town's annual report for CMOM (Capacity Management and Operations and Maintenance) for the wastewater collection system.
  The Public Works Director reported the following:
  - The CMOM program is an EPA requirement, which is designed to eliminate sewer overflows into the bay.
  - He has also enclosed a draft of two informational pamphlets that will be distributed in the upcoming weeks.
  - o The Town will be targeting the West Ferry area to begin the program.
