REPORT OF TOWN OFFICIALS

1) **Pumping Report:**

The Public Works Director reported the following:

- JR-1 has been in service since May.
- Pumping was down for the month of September.
- Rainfall was up for the month of September, compared to August.
- North Reservoir is @ 40MG, usable storage-60MG.
- South Pond is @ 6MG, usable storage-6MG

2) Town project reports: (See Project Update Report dated September 2015) Treatment Plant:

The Public Works Director reported the following:

- Two check valves were replaced in the wet well at the Treatment Plant. The valves were found to be leaking water into the tank from the distribution system when the pumps were off. The Public Works Director briefly described the incident.
- Staff installed a second water level sensor in the wet well, as a back-up.
- The fire alarm system was replaced at the Treatment Plant. The system failed during a recent storm.

Distribution System:

The Public Works Director reported that work on the installation of the water main on High Street was suspended due to the road paving projects with Cardi Corporation. Work will resume after the Columbus Day holiday.

Wastewater Treatment Plant:

The Public Works Director reported that the Sanitary Sewer Lining and Rehabilitation Project was re-bid and that two bids were received and reviewed. The Public Works Director recommended that the project be awarded to Green Mountain Pipeline Services in an amount not to exceed \$372,900.
