one-hundredths (669.48) feet for a distance of four hundred fifty and forty—two one-hundredths (450.42) feet to a point, said point being opposite and forty (40) feet northwesterly from said traverse line at Sta. 50+50.30; thence southwesterly in a straight line to a point, said point being opposite and twenty-five (25) feet westerly from said traverse line at Sta. 54+18.70 and also said point being in the westerly highway line of Beavertail Road, so-called, as established by Plat No. 245 by the Rhode Island State Board of Public Roads (now the Rhode Island Department of Public Works - Division of Roads and Bridges) and filed in the office of the Town Clerk of Jamestown on November 15, 1928 and all as shown upon the aforesaid Plat No. 693.
