Ft. Getty Workshop

On May 19, 2011 the Jamestown Town Council held a public facilitated workshop. This workshop gauged public opinion on:

- 1) The best use(s) for Ft. Getty Town Park
- 2) Whether revenue generation should be integral to park operation
- 3) Whether to keep, eliminate or reduce the size of the RV Park

125 participants attended the workshop and 111 participants voted.
