Minutes of the January 9, 2013 Meeting of the Jamestown Harbor Commission Approved: 2/13/2013

A meeting of the Jamestown Harbor Commission (JHC) was held Wednesday, January 9, 2013 at the Jamestown Town Hall, 93 Narragansett Avenue, Jamestown, Rhode Island.
